A subcommittee consisting of Bonnie Paiva, Jennifer Pacheco, Lynn Iadicola and Lynne Olsen-Vieira met on Tuesday 8/28/18 to review and rank the renewal projects that will be part of the Fall River CoC application this year.

After careful thought and consideration, the subcommittee formulated the ranking, of the 11 programs for the CoC application that you find below. In reaching a decision, the subcommittee took into consideration the importance of several factors: utilization of contract funds for the previous year as well as a review of programmatic performance measures. Please note that the performance indicator of percent of participants with zero income at entry was not factored in due to all projects performance on this being below the HUD minimum (80%). Also note that the performance indicator of percent of participants entering project from place not meant for human habitation was factored into our decision making since the committee was able to obtain the project information that was inclusive of Emergency Shelters.

The recommendation committee is grateful for the opportunity to be a part of the review process and appreciative of the time that representatives from all of the projects gave in meeting with us to explain their projects and answer our questions.
